Meet ISOO Member, Ivan Alajbeg

Prof. Ivan Alajbeg is an Oral Medicine Specialist at the University of Zagreb's School of Dental Medicine and University Hospital Center in Zagreb, Croatia. He has been working in the field of Oral Medicine since 1998. At the School of Dental Medicine, Ivan is a course lead in two courses which he introduced to the curriculum: Dental Care of Medically Complex Patients, and Tobacco Cessation and Prevention for Oral Healthcare Professionals. He also serves as the Vice-Dean for International Cooperation, which gives him the fantastic opportunity to meet and work with interesting and driven people from all over the world.

Ivan understands the struggles that other ISOO members have had in the past in terms of providing standardized oral care for oncology patients as this has been a problem in Croatia.



For the past five years he has been focusing his efforts on improving clinical care for patients. He has achieved momentum by partnering with medical doctors (head and neck surgeons, radiation oncologists, and a medical oncologist) who want the same excellent care for patients. Against many obstacles and odds, Ivan is rewarded by his advances in persuading patients and healthcare providers to see that excellent supportive oral care is achievable. He feels that he is often pushing against 'headwinds', but ISOO has been instrumental in creating a 'tailwind'. He is thankful to have others in the ISOO community that have been pioneers in their own countries, who are able to offer advice and support. A favorite quote that gives him perspective in his efforts is: "The struggle itself is enough to fill a man's heart. One must imagine Sisyphus happy."

Ivan is married to Iva, an Associate Professor of Prosthetic Dentistry, and they have a 16 year old daughter, Jana. He is a certified ski instructor, a passionate skipper doing quite a bit of sailing in the Adriatic, and he enjoys spear-fishing. He has a special love for his 10 foot dinghy (just a bit larger than a bath tub) with 18 hp, affectionately called "a suicidal kidney stone breaker".
